

# CLASSIC CAR DECLARATION MOTOR VEHICLES

**GN CODE 9705 Collections of objects for collections of a zoological, botanical, mineralogical, anatomical, historical, archaeological, paleontological, ethnographical or numismatic importance**

1. This item includes motor vehicles which:
  - - are in their original condition, without fundamental changes to the chassis, the steering system or the brake system, the engine, etc.;
  - - are at least 30 years old; and
  - - are of a model or type no longer in production.
  
- Motor vehicles are however not considered to be of historical or ethnographic importance and are excluded from this item if the competent authorities determine that the motor vehicles do not illustrate any characteristic step in the development of human achievement, or a period in that development. Such vehicles must therefore possess the required characteristics for inclusion in a collection by:
  - - being relatively rare;
  - - normally speaking, not being used for their original purpose;
  - - forming the subject of special transactions beyond the normal trade in such consumer articles; and
  - - having a higher value.
  
2. This item also includes as collector's objects of historical importance:
  - a. motor vehicles, irrespective of year of construction, which can be demonstrated to have been used in a historical event;
  - b. racing motor vehicles, which can be demonstrated that they were exclusively designed, built and used for races, and achieved important sporting success in well-known national or international events.
  
3. Articles used as parts of or accessories to the above mentioned vehicles are classified in this item if they themselves are collector's objects, irrespective of whether they were intended for installation on or in these vehicles. The proof can be provided in the form of suitable documentation, for example reference works or specialist literature, or declarations from recognised experts. The explanatory notes hereinabove apply mutatis mutandis to motorcycles.

Replicas are always excluded from this item.

# CLASSIC CAR DECLARATION MOTOR VEHICLES

By signing this declaration, the client is aware that he/she can/will be personally held fully responsible by the Customs Authority for inaccuracies and/or incomplete details as specified in the customs declaration (all on the basis of the instructions and/or information issued by him/her to the logistic service provider).
